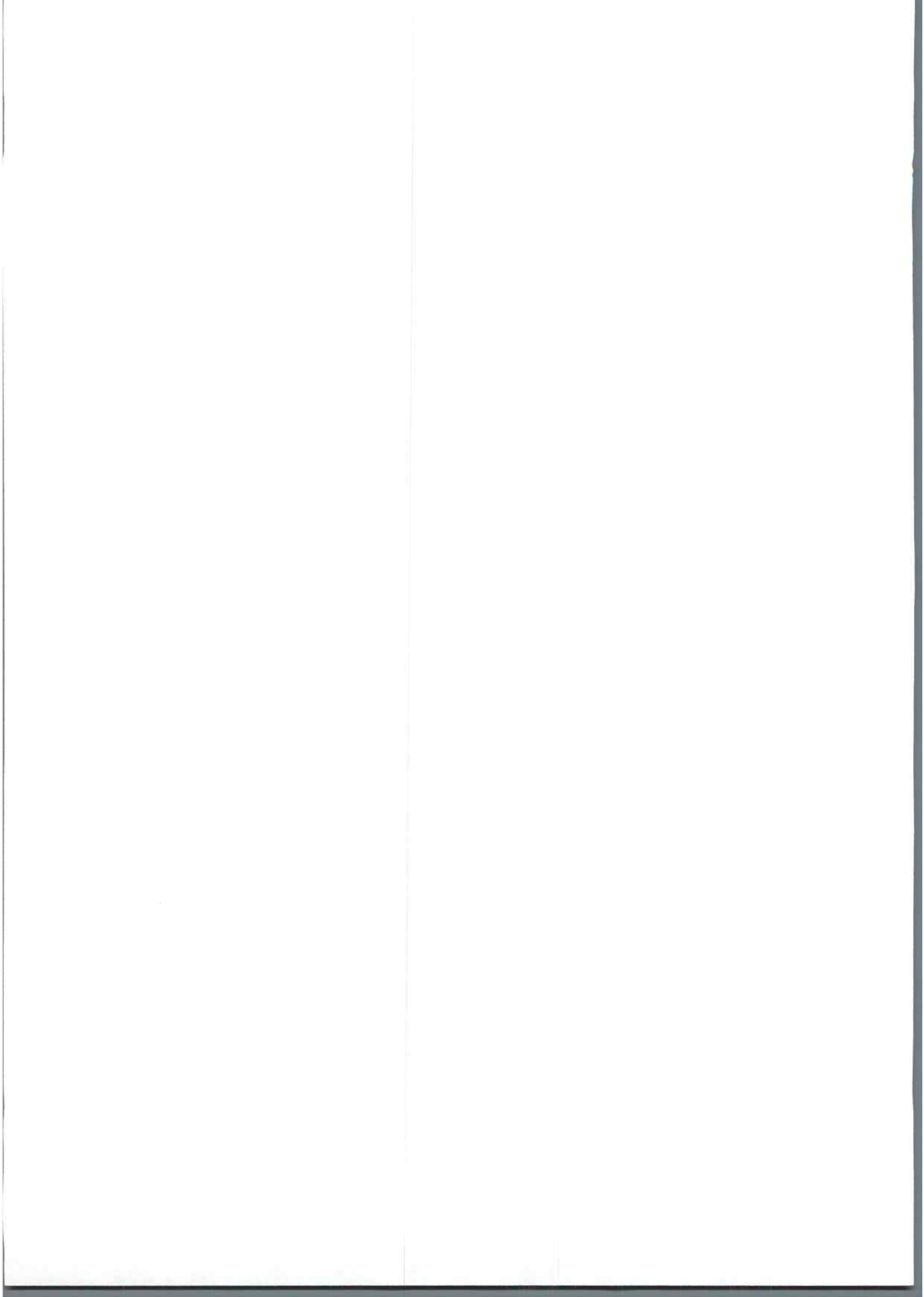

By five o'clock we had been sitting on a log near the highway and waiting for the sun ¹⁸⁰ to set. ¹⁹⁰

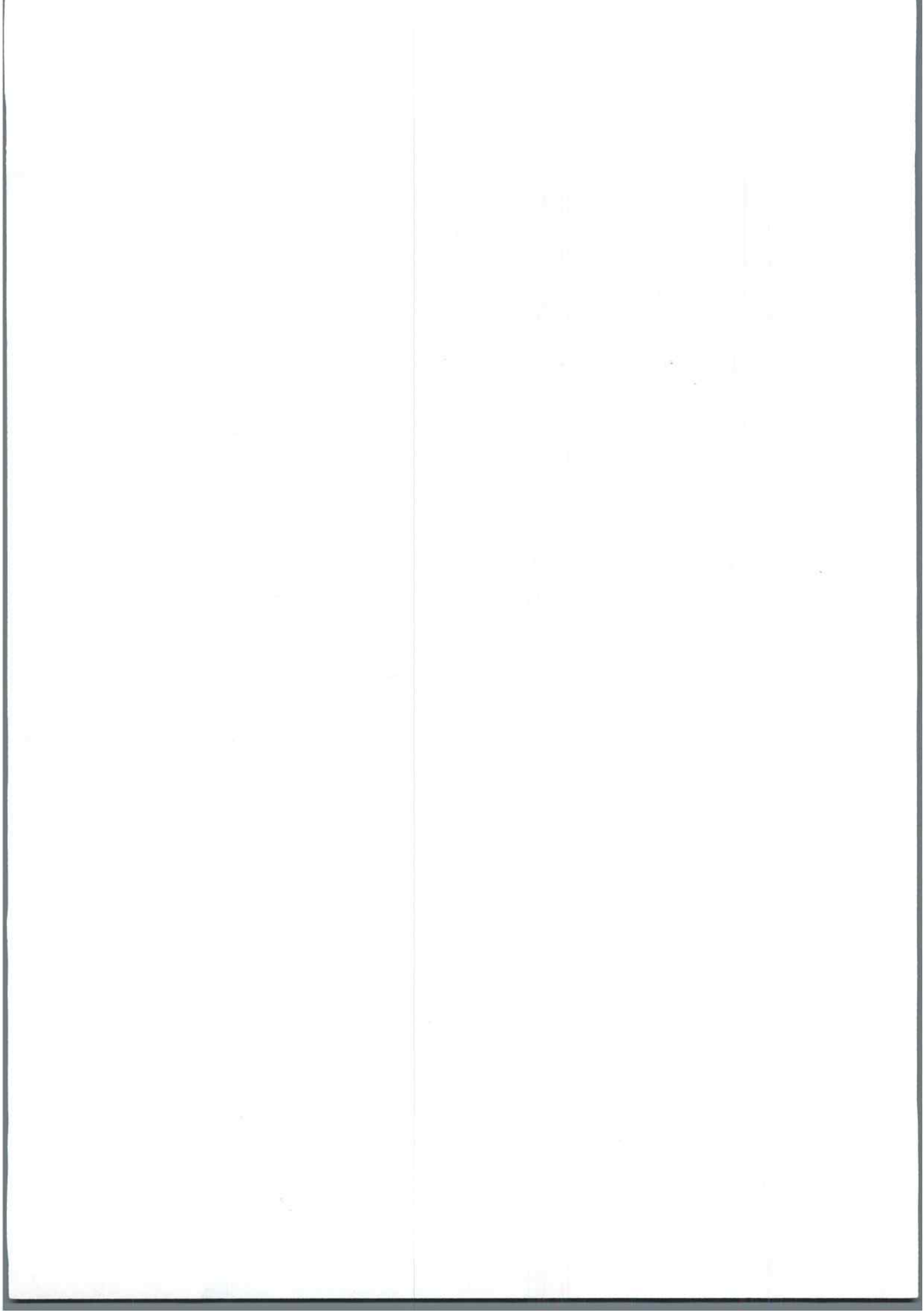
"Tell me your biggest secret, dad!" - I was ¹⁸⁰ asked
